

- All court cases shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Rajasthan Technical University Headquarter i.e. Kota and not any other place.
- For any kind of improvement as per rules, the student has to apply within one month of the declaration of the result in their Institute.
- Term Test: A student is allowed to improve the term tests if he/she is appearing in the University Examination of that theory paper again and if failing earlier, if a student has applied for improvement of term tests marks, the marks secured by him/her in previous term test shall stand automatically cancelled. The marks of the latest examination tests shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a candidate has absented himself/herself from the test, he/she shall be treated as absent.
- Sessional improvement: If the student is failing in any practical and/or sessional subject(s), he/she can apply for improvement in the sessional component provided the earlier marks in the sessional component are less than 40%. The student will be required to register in both practical and sessional components of the subject(s) and his/her marks of the latest practical & sessional examination shall only be considered for working out the result. If such a student has absented himself/herself from the test, then he/she shall be treated as absent.
- Medium of instruction of the programme is English only.
